# School Advisory Council (SAC)

Our next meeting is Tuesday, January 21 at 4:30 pm. All welcome to attend.

Our school advisory council has an annual budget of \$5000.00 plus \$1.00 per student (\$5601.00) to spend in the areas of integrated math, literacy and well-being. The SAC approved additional art classes for each class. Belle DeMont (HRCE teacher, art teacher, author of '*I Love* 

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*My Purse'*, and illustrator of '*The Little Tree By the Sea'* ) has been hired over the next few weeks to work with teachers and students on various art projects. Each class will receive two hours of art classes.

The remainder of the budget will be put towards having an expert teach a science class. Teachers will choose either an online science class or a visit from the Discovery center. This will be happening throughout the remainder of the school year.

#### **LMST Receives French Cultural Grant**

We have received a French Cultural Connection Grant from HRCE that we will be using to enrich our students' learning and broaden their perspectives regarding the Acadian culture.
