# Last Meeting June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023

- 1. Review and approval of minutes Members approved the minutes from June 20th, 2023 meeting.
- 2. Additions of any other business to the agenda Student attendance and engagement policy.

#### **Discussion of New Business**

3. Student attendance and engagement policy. In 2017 provincial school attendance in middle and high school became a problem. The student attendance and engagement policy was designed as a framework to help students get to school. During covid it was suspended and re-instated in September 2023. At LMST there are some students that do not attend, our school works with the parents and social worker to help facilitate attendance. Support is there for children to attend school (ie.courtesy bussing, follow up with parents)

**Update on playground: LMST newest** playground (only 4 years old) is fine structurally but there are some areas of rot in the natural wood space. Discussions ongoing regarding what remedies are needed. The city is responsible for maintenance of the playgrounds.
