AND <u>child abuse registry check</u> When submitting your criminal record check be sure to link and share your application with LMST elementary. The criminal record check (police) and the child abuse registry check (community services) are two separate processes.

Please note- this process can take weeks. To volunteer both checks must be completed and submitted to the office.
